

Not an election issue?

The Government would like you to believe that the controversial power station and data centre at Tuggeranong is not an election issue.

Canberrans for Power station Relocation Inc disagrees.

CPR Inc today are releasing figures supporting the scale of opposition to the Stanhope Government's mishandling of this project and its unsuitable location close to residential suburbs on Broadacre rural buffer land.

- Our website, www.nopowerstation.com, has been operational since mid May and in 5 months we have to date served almost 10,000 visitors viewing 30,000 pages
- Our petition tabled in the Assembly, calling for no power station to be built near residential suburbs, totals over 4,000 signatures from 90 suburbs across Canberra
- Email subscribers, who signed up for updates via our website, total over 300 members receiving regular updates and our Facebook group - "NO" to a Dirty Power Station Near Suburbs - has over 250 members

CPR Inc has invited the political parties to attend our meetings to discuss our issues.

- Thursday 2 October, ACT Liberals will attend
- ACT Labor have not been confirmed
